3-rd E-Classes meeting, Sofia (Bulgaria)

E-Classes 3-rd partners' meeting took place in Sofia, Bulgaria, on 2-3-rd October 2018 and was hosted by the Bulgarian Association of Networking Academies.

The focus of the third meeting was on:

- Presentation of the final form of the Guide and the tutorials created by the partners
- Common debate on the possible issues, contents, form, practical aspects
- Establishing the frame and format for the final presentation of the Guide + tutorials for the Open-Online Course on Flipped classes methodology for VET teachers
- Establishing details for Pilot of the online course (1 staff member will test the course functionality): YouTube Channel, e-learning platform, website.
- Preparation of C1 - International training for teachers/trainers in Madrid
- The website - structure and contents of the website; integrating IO1, IO3, IO4 into the website – possible solutions
- Dissemination activities – the common dissemination plan – tasks and future activities
- Preparation stages for IO3 – the Flipped lessons
- Debate on common frame and technical details for the videos
- Administrative and management issues

E-Classes wants to help the VET teachers in revising and strengthening the professional profile and improving the attainment of young people, particularly those at risk of early school leaving and with low basic skills, developing a methodology especially focusing on the use of ICT.

The project activities for the period June - October 2018 were focused on the final stage of developing the Guideline on Flipped classroom methodology – creating videos and their translation in 4 languages of the partners – Bulgarian, Italian, Romanian and Spanish, published in YouTube at https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCwFB1nW_XJN4g9igBtiDfvq.

Guideline will be the focus of the International training of teachers – C1 that will take place on 26-30 November in Madrid, Spain. 23 teachers from 4 countries will be introduced to the methodology of creating flipped lessons, will evaluate the guideline and give their feedback for the purpose of improving it.

All partners organized a series of events to disseminate the project, its activities and plans at schools, VET centres etc.



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
