Final project meeting, 12th-13th Florence 2019

The final project meeting for E-CLASSES project was a great opportunity for all key participants from all partner organizations involved in the project to meet and evaluate the results of the project and the main achievements within the 2 years of work.

The focus of the meeting was to evaluate all Intellectual Outcomes with a special focus on the online resources created by the help of this project: The website of the project and The e-learning Moodle platform.

The approach and methods proposed by E-CLASSES project had a very positive feed-back, both on teachers and students involved. Teachers have received with openness and interest the flipped classes methodology as it seems to respond to some actual and urgent needs of the modern teachers - adapting their methods and approaches in learning to the new requirements of the digital native students. On the other hand, students showed interest and disponibility to try the method and to work in this way, sustaining their teachers in learning and developing the method.

The project raised the attention of teachers, schools principals and counselors and attention of experts in education by highlighting the potential and benefits that new technology offers teachers and how teachers can take advantage of its channels, join their efforts in learning communities and raise students' interest in learning. In addition, the project adds value to flipped classroom principles by involving companies in the educational process through multimedia enriched apprenticeship simulations.

One of the greatest benefits of flipping is that overall interaction increases: teacher-to-student, and student-to-student. It's all about redirecting attention away from the teacher and putting attention on the learner and the learning.
